Dr Rickard was appointed Chief Radiologist for Sydney Breast Clinic in 2006. She also holds a position of Adjunct Professor at the University of Sydney in the Discipline of Medical Radiation Sciences.

Following graduation from the University of Sydney she obtained the fellowship of the College of Radiologists (RANZCR) in 1981.

In 1987 Dr Rickard was appointed to establish a Sydney-based pilot mammography screening project, later part of BreastScreen Australia.

She has taken a keen interest in breast imaging technique and interpretation, in new technologies, and in professional training. Dr Rickard was State Radiologist for BreastScreen NSW (2001-2006).

In 2002 she received a Member of the Order of Australia award, for service to medicine through the integration of population based screening for early detection of breast cancer, and the development of education programmes for health professionals.

In 2015 she was elected a Life Member of the College of Radiologists (RANZCR) in recognition of her outstanding contribution to the College and to the profession.
